CIRCULAR

Sub: National Deworming Campaign 10<sup>th</sup> to 17<sup>th</sup> October, 2023.

National Deworming Campaign is scheduled to be held from 10<sup>th</sup> to 17<sup>th</sup> October, 2023 under the guidance of Directorate of Family Welfare, GNCTD. The campaign involves administration of single age appropriate dose of Albendazole to all children and adolescents in the age group of 1-19 years.

To ensure the above, all Heads of Schools of Govt./Govt. Aided and Private Unaided Recognized Schools under Directorate of Education, GNCTD are directed to extend necessary support to the campaign. It is also directed that following guidelines may be adhered to

1. An active participation of all Delhi Govt./Govt. Aided schools in the campaign and ensure optimum coverage (of not less than 100% of enrolled children).
2. The participation of Nodal teachers (from all schools Govt./Aided) in orientation session/refresher training as well as timely submission of reports (latest within 15 days of the culmination of campaign).
3. An active participation of Private/unaided schools to be ensured and preferably not less than 75% coverage of enrolled children.
4. Participation of Nodal Teacher (from all Private Unaided Recognized Schools) in orientation session/refresher training as well as timely submission of reports (latest within 15 days of the culmination of campaign).
5. Supportive supervision of the campaign activity by Head of School & Nodal Teachers. Allow National, State & District monitors to visit the school premises to witness and record the activities under the campaign.

The Albendazole tablet and IEC material will be collected by the schools from designated stores of School Health Scheme, DGHS and administration to students be done from 10<sup>th</sup> to 17<sup>th</sup> October, 2023. List of District Incharge of School Health Scheme, DGHS at - Annexure - A.

Further, to ascertain a successful National Deworming Campaign, HoSs/Teachers will disseminate standardized information shared by Family Welfare Department to all parents, students and SMC Members. (Annexure - B and C)

A reporting format with respect to the National Deworming Campaign is to be filled by HoSs of all Schools and submitted to DDE (Zones). All DDE (Zones) will submit all reporting formats to respective Districts Medical Officer Incharge of School Health Scheme. (Annexure - D)

An Adverse Event Management System will be put in place to tackle any exigencies during the campaign. The details regarding this will be shared with Nodal Teachers during the training.
